Cybersecurity

We share the cybersecurity management with Manuport Logistics ensuring robust protection of operations and data. This management is independent from Euroports, allowing Manuport Road Transport and Manuport Logistics to focus on their specific cybersecurity needs and compliance with industry standards.

In 2023, Manuport Logistics reported zero breaches of confidential information, demonstrating the effectiveness of its cybersecurity measures and improving the performance of the system compared to previous years. Additionally, yearly cybersecurity audits are conducted to assess and improve the security framework, ensuring ongoing protection against potential cyber threats. 

Hence, the emissions related to our own operation have been already taken into account in both Manuport Logistics and Euroports carbon inventory, which is done in partnership with Deloitte.

Initiatives for emissions reduction

Our road division in France is accelerating on this subject by being among the first road freight forwarders in France to sign the EVcom charter in 2023, which sets a quantitative target of 5% reduction in GHG emissions from participants' activities over 3 years. This voluntary approach is a first step that we hope to see grow year after year for our Rouen and La Rochelle offices, thanks to the essential support of our partners.

This dedication to H&S is integral to our operations, helping us to work better and provide great service, reflecting our commitment to safeguarding the well-being of all stakeholders.






Furthermore, we offer health insurance and pension scheme. On top of these, employees also can benefit from flexible working schedules and location, either by default or upon request, depending on the specific office.

These benefits show our trust in our employees and our dedication to supporting our team and creating a positive workplace.


MRT Employees with additional pension scheme in 2023

ESG Certifications & Sustainability Assessments

Manuport Road Transport holds ESG certifications, including SQAS for quality and safety (Belgium), Feed Chain Alliance for feed safety and traceability (Belgium, division Ghent), and Qualimat (France) for feed material safety. These certifications ensure high standards in logistics operations, emphasizing sustainability, hygiene, and compliance with industry regulations.



The SQAS (Safety & Quality Assessment for Sustainability) certification evaluates the quality, safety, security, and environmental performance of logistics service providers. It provides standardized assessments used by companies to improve supply chain sustainability.



The Feed Chain Alliance (FCA) certification guarantees the safety, quality, and traceability of animal feed throughout the supply chain. For us, this certification is key as it ensures compliance with legal requirements and good manufacturing practices, preventing contamination and maintaining high-quality feed during transportation.



The Qualimat certification focuses on the safety and quality of feed materials during transportation and storage. For Manuport Road Transport, this certification is important as it emphasizes hygiene, contamination prevention, and traceability, ensuring that feed materials remain safe and uncontaminated throughout the logistics process.



The EcoVadis sustainability assessment is a comprehensive tool that evaluates our company's sustainability performance across four key areas: Environment, Labor & Human Rights, Ethics, and Sustainable Procurement. This year, as part of the Manuport Logistics Group, we obtained a Bronze Medal.
